

Start-ups raise funds on-the-spot at NASSCOM 10,000 Start-ups TechStock

Prototype stage ventures - VioletStreet & Ziffy raise 10 lakh each

14th May, Hyderabad- As part of its Great Indian Start-up Carnival, NASSCOM's 10,000 Start-ups program organized an on-the-spot funding event for prototype stage companies in Hyderabad. At the event, 9 prototype stage tech start-ups addressed a diverse range of industries from Media to Finance, to a panel of 8 angel investors and mentors.

The two of the prototype ventures that pitched – [VioletStreet](#) and [Ziffy](#) successfully raised 10 lakh each for an equity of 10 percent. VioletStreet is a social fashion ecommerce portal and Ziffy is a ridesharing app with an innovative business model different from most carpooling ventures. The investors decided to invest in the start-ups on the basis of the concept, market opportunity, quality of the product and ability of the team to execute. This is the third occasion when 10,000 Start-ups has conducted an on-the-spot funding event, the previous editions were conducted in Bangalore and Mumbai.

On the sidelines of the occasion, **Mr. Rajat Tandon, Senior Director, NASSCOM 10,000 Start-ups** said, *"The 10,000 Start-ups program was envisioned to bridge the gap in terms of the support available to early stage companies especially when they are trying to go from a technological prototype to building a profitable and sustainable business venture. As an ecosystem we need to make the cost of failure small and we don't just need more enterprising founders but also investors who are willing to take risks and also willing to handhold these ventures in this critical stage of their evolution. We are delighted to see two of these ventures funded on the spot and would like to thank Hyderabad Angels for having the confidence in executing this model."*

The Techstock event was conducted at TiE Smashup Hyderabad and as part of the Great Indian Start-up Carnival which 10,000 Start-ups is organizing in the run-up to its 3rd round of applications that would open tentatively in the second week of June 2014.
